



## TE TIRA HOE O WAIKATO 2015

Te Tira Hoe o Waikato 2015 is an opportunity for Registered Tribal Members of Waikato-Tainui to take a journey on the Waikato Awa aimed at reinforcing the relationship between our people and our Tupuna awa.

The journey covers a distance of 125km by river and 300 kms by road, from the source of the awa at Waikato Iti to the mouth at Te Puuaha o Waikato.

This initiative is planned to take place of Easter next year and will also include an Orientation Day the weekend prior.

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$100 to assist with all associated costs of the event including Orientation, Workshops & Activities, Equipment, Meals & Accommodation, Resource Kits and Te Tira Hoe o Waikato 2015 branded clothing.
